Absences

If your child is poorly and unable to attend school, can we ask that you ring into school each morning they are absent. An answer service is available – so if you are unable to speak direct to a member of the office staff please leave a message.

Parents will note that the attendance figures quoted above are STILL well below our usual standard. Pupils who have attendance rate of 90% is equivalent to having 19 days absent from school – over the year this accumulates to 100 missed lessons! **EVERYDAY AT SCHOOL MATTERS** & missing days at school has a bearing on your child's education.

Punctuality

As well as regular attendance at school, parents need to ensure that their child arrives at school in good time each morning.

Being late for school has many negative consequences:

- Gets the day off to a bad start
- Increases stress and upset for the child
- Can lead to the child feeling embarrassed and singled out
- Affects the child's overall confidence
- Disrupts the learning of other class members
- Creates bad habits which could lead to poor attendance
- Confusion for your child as work or activities might have been started

Don't be late through the gate!

5 Minutes late every day	3.4 days of learning lost every year
10 minutes late every day	6.9 days of learning lost every year
15 minutes late every day	10.3 days of learning lost every year
20 minutes late every day	13.8 days of learning lost every year
30 Minutes late every day	20.7 days of learning lost every year

Medical, dental and optician appointments should be made with the least disruption to your child's learning and where possible, after school or during school holidays
