## **Driving Incidents Around School – 'Near misses'**

It is very important for all of our children and families to feel safe on their way to and from school. I opened up the emergency gates on Moxley Road to help improve the queues and frustrations at home time. This has led to more parents parking on the grass and driving over pavements. Children have had to jump out of the way of moving cars. In addition to this, cars have been parked carelessly and blocked the emergency gate access – this should not happen. The gates need to be clear in case of an emergency.

**Please be considerate** when driving to school to collect your children by parking a short distance away from the gates. This will help to keep all children safe.

If this parking system does not improve, I will have to consider whether to continue using the entrance.
